Descriptions: Parent Volunteer Jobs

Classroom Assistants: Escort campers to each daily activity and assist the Korean staff as necessary.

Child Care Coordinators: Coordinate volunteer coverage for Child Care area.

Child Care Assistants: Supervise play of babies and toddlers for parents volunteering elsewhere.

Arts/Crafts Aides: Assist Art Coordinator in daily art projects.

Food Preparation: Assist with preparation and serving of meals/snacks and learn about Korean cooking; clean-up after meals; supervise/assist younger campers during lunch. (Must be an adult to work in the school kitchen)

Custodial Assistant/Helpers: Set up rooms, clean kitchen and dining room after meals, empty garbage at end of day, help keep facility clean.

Nurse or Doctor: Persons to assist with medical needs and hand out first aid supplies at first aid station.

Fundraising: Contact local businesses to help generate donations for camp. (Will work closely with board members.)

Chaperone: Accompany children to offsite outings (e.g. bowling on Wed. afternoon)
